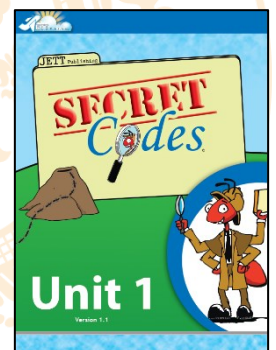

Dr. Hermansson has taught English literature at Pittsburg State University since 1997 (PhD, University of Toronto). In 2014 she was a Fulbright scholar at Åbo Akademi University and the University of Turku, and has returned several times since then. She has published academic monographs on the Bluebeard fairy tale, Peter Pan in film adaptation, and adapting children's metafiction to film. She has edited two scholarly collections on adaptation and on children's media. She has also published for children and youth in education markets, including 2 non-fiction books and 22 short fiction books for Heinemann Education.

Dr. Hermansson will discuss the Kansas Blueprint for Literacy (recently passed into State law), the role of the Pittsburg State University Center for READING in advocating for a return to structured literacy to teach reading, and her new collaboration as "resident author" with the Center to write literature to enrich the *Secret Codes* curriculum.
